

**Re: Level 5 Certificate in Teaching Primary Physical Education and  
Level 6 Certificate in Leading and Managing Improvement in Primary Physical Education.**

These two qualifications are bespoke primary school physical education qualifications for primary school teachers, higher level teaching assistants and teaching assistants delivering PE developed by the Association for Physical Education (AfPE) and Sports Leaders UK.

**The Level 5 Certificate** in Primary School Physical Education Specialism is open to teachers, higher level teaching assistants and teaching assistants who have supported and delivered the PE curriculum (with a supporting letter from the school to state this) to assist in raising standards within primary school education. (6 Days)

**The Level 6 Award** in Primary School Physical Education Subject Leadership will allow primary school teachers to take the lead in delivering sustainable high quality primary school physical education. (This is only open to teachers with QTS) (2 Days)

Dacorum School Sports Network, Stanborough School and Richard Hale School on behalf of the 3 districts of Dacorum, Welwyn and Hatfield and Hertford and Ware have been running this course since academic year 2013-2014. These courses are now open to all schools in Hertfordshire and the surrounding counties We are now seeking expressions of interest for September 2017 to assess potential numbers .

The cost last year was £1375 per delegate which involves £175 for registration and the equivalent of £150 per day for the delivery of 6 days in the first year (Level 5) and 2 days in the second year, (Level 6). Schools may elect for HLTA's just to attend the Level 5 which costs £1075.

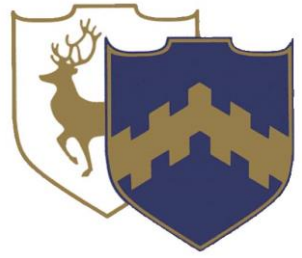
